Its campus is located in the city of Camas, Washington. The school's building features computer labs, more than 60 classrooms, gymnasiums, wrestling and weight rooms, aerobics room, a career center, integrated science labs, a student-run credit union and student store, and an auditorium with capacity of over 600 persons.

The A Concise Overview of the Camas High School Timeline has a strong reputation for its student code of conduct and rigorous academic standards. In addition, its sports teams are well known for their high quality of play.

A large percentage of the community supports the school and the many events and activities it hosts. Moreover, its teachers are highly qualified and highly motivated to provide students with the best education possible.

In the early days, Camas High School was shaped by its relationship with the paper mill that dominated the community.

The mill owners funded the schools to educate the next generation of workers in a trade that would help them earn a living and a better future for their families.

The school also benefited from the support of community organizations like the Lions and Kiwanis clubs. They collected funds for local needs, primarily youth activities. Purpose of timeline overview



Construction of the school building

When construction is complete, Camas Ridge will have a brand new school building for the students in its neighborhood.

This new building will be designed for safety and security, efficiency and sustainability, and modern teaching and learning.

While the construction is underway, Camas Ridge students and staff have relocated to a temporary school site on the Willard property at 29th and Lincoln. They will stay there until the new school building opens in 2024.



This will give them a place to study and do other things during the construction. It will also allow them to take some of their beloved items with them to their new home, such as art murals or the pink bench that honors Mouhammadou Faye, a student who died in 2018.

DLR Group was asked by Camas School District to design a school for high school students that would reflect a modern approach to learning. The district's community had input throughout the design process.

The new school features a project-based learning curriculum for students in 9th through 12th grade, a continuation of the program from the project-based learning middle school. This curriculum focuses on collaborative, integrated learning teams.

In addition, the new school reflects the district's commitment to energy conservation and sustainable building practices. The building's orientation along an East-West axis minimizes sun exposure, reduces heat gain, and captures natural daylight with operable windows and continuous clerestory.

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First year of student enrollment

Located in Camas, Washington, Camas High School provides various educational opportunities to students from grades

nine through 12. The school is governed by the Camas School District.

CHS provides several different types of academic opportunities including: American English, science, math, art, vocational education, social sciences and physical education. Students can also choose to take at-level courses or advanced

placement courses in a variety of subjects.

In addition to academics, CHS supports athletics. It competes in the Greater St. Helens League of WIAA District IV and provides multiple sports, including wrestling, boys' and girls' volleyball, football, baseball, cross country, softball, golf and

tennis.

Students are able to take classes in the arts, as well, such as music and art. Additionally, the school offers courses in the

fields of business, computer sciences and engineering.
